TRAILS END WATER DISTRICT 3/22/19 Working Session MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER: The working session came to order at 10:00 am

ATTENDANCE: Deb Watson, Joe Morris, Sarah Carlson, Commissioners

DISCUSSION TOPICS:

Property at 1111 has received a permit from the county to install a septic system. The land has already been cleared and they have started work. However, the owners have not requested a hook-up. Joe will be checking with the county to see if a septic system can be installed without water. There is concern that the property next door has a well and that the new owner of this property is planning to use that well.

Joe reported that Northwest Resources is working on the study but there are no results yet.

Joe also reported that he has been regularly testing and operating the generator. Yesterday, when he tried to test it, something went snap and the generator won't start up. He will try to diagnosis the issue. Deb reported that Noah, our expert, is scheduled to do routine maintenance anyway, so he can look at it and fix it if necessary. She sent a text Noah and requested he come next week.

There may be an issue with the level of the lake that may indirectly be an issue for the district. A home owner has put a board across the water egress which has risen the level of the lake for about 6" above normal. This impacts the ability of water to drain during heavy rains. This might impact our aquafer. We will keep an eye on this issue in the future.
