We also discussed the shut-off notices. We have received the door hangers. We reviewed those accounts that would be getting the notices. Because they will be eligible for shut-off on 10/15/16, which is a Saturday, it was decided to put them out Monday, 10/17/17. This will give customers two full business days to get payments in before they are disconnected.

During our discussion on the shut-off notices, the question of the four groups and/or people living permanently in camping situations was brought up. It appears they are paying money to the owner to stay there and he is not willing to do anything about them. However, there does not seem to be a septic tank with bathroom facilities there. We are concerned about waste, how close it may be to the lines, etc. Research was done and the Mason Code was found that deals with such issues. Joe will do some more checking into the exact conditions and laws.
