**“Verified Voter Pilot Project”** – The Mason County Auditor sent an e-mail about a new voter pilot project that is beginning with the 4/28/26 special election. Basically, the county is going to try a new voter verification program that requires voters to include their birthdate and a valid WA driver’s license or identification card. Since this is a pilot project it is voluntary. Districts can opt out by petitioning the Commissioners for a waiver. As a group there were a few questions. Ms. Carlson will contact the auditor’s office for clarification and the topic will be put on the agenda in January.

With the storms, we have been lucky that no issues have arisen. Joe continues to troubleshoot on the leak or possible seepage. We may know more after the meters are read on 12/30/25.

Ms. Snow and Ms. Carlson have both been working on getting all of the forms updated for the upcoming 2026 fiscal year and closing out 2025.
